Children's Response Center was developed by members of the Eastside community who wanted to recognize and respond to the needs of child victims of sexual abuse or other traumatic events and their families. The members formed an Advisory Board, whose commitment reflected concern and passion for the well being of children. The commitment for the mission of the Center continues today through the work of the Board and staff.

CHILDREN'S RESPONSE CENTER'S DEDICATED ADVISORY BOARD:

The purpose of the Advisory Board of the Children's Response Center is to support the mission of the Center by recommending policy, providing financial and advisory support and increasing public awareness through community education. The Board is responsible for assisting the Director in carrying out the goals and objectives of the organization. The duties and responsibilities of a board member include:

- Understanding the Center's needs and those of the children and families seeking services.
- Regular attendance and active participation in monthly board meetings.
- Active participation in at least one council or committee as identified in the bylaws.
- Advocacy for the Center in the community and at all levels of government.
- Participation in fundraising initiatives.
- Providing personal financial support.

Individuals with a passion for improving the lives of children are key to the Center's effective leadership. Board Members represent many different communities and vocations in East and North King County, including both public and private sectors.
