Our presentation is ideal for a health or psychology class. Our presentation includes video, activities, discussion, and power point presentation. We will try to accommodate your needs.



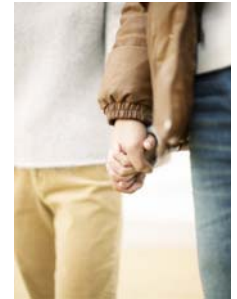
